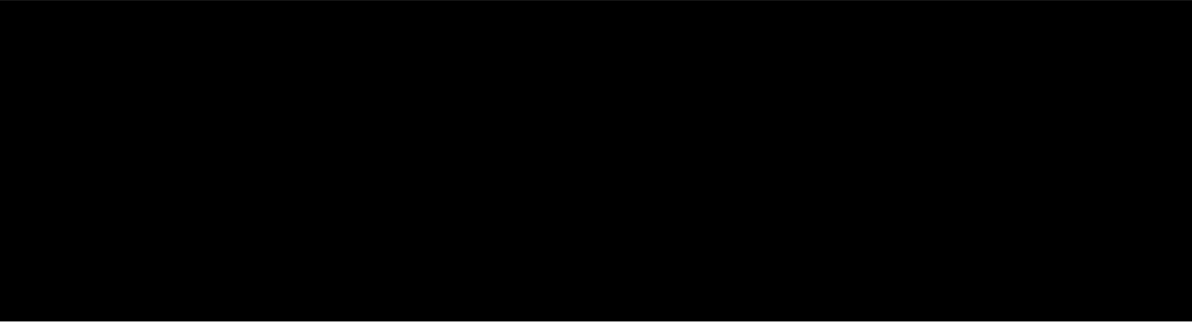

SUPPLEMENT TO REPORT NO.



1. President Juan Manuel Galvez of Honduras reportedly met with Guatemalan Chief of Armed Forces Francisco Arana at Lake Ujoa near the common frontier at some time between 18 February and 28 February, to discuss subjects of mutual interest. They are said to have signed a mutual friendship and assistance pact, which was in the nature of an agreement between individuals rather than governments. Political agreements involving their two governments are considered a logical corollary to such a pact, however. No further details were reported.
2. Arana travelled to the meeting place in a plane of the United Fruit Company, which maintains an airfield near the Lake Ujoa area. 25X1X6
3. [REDACTED] Galvez now felt perfectly secure in his position and feared nothing from any machinations of Honduran revolutionary groups, whether supported by Arevalo or Carias.
